FINDING ITEMS IN THE MINING ENVIRONMENT DATABASE

Locations in the J.N. Desmarais Library

References from the Mining Environment Database are fully integrated into the circulating, journal, government document and vertical file collections of the J.N. Desmarais Library. The majority of database citations can be found in four areas of the Desmarais Library, as described below.

Location and holdings information for items in the Database appear at the *bottom* of the screen, in the *Full display* version of citations. Please consult [Searching the Mining Environment Database](#) for a more detailed explanation of *Brief display*, *Full display*, and *Complete display* of citations.

VERTICAL FILES (1ST FLOOR)

Items with the location "VERTICAL FILES (1ST FLOOR)" can be found in the [Archives and Rare Books](#) section of the Library, on the first floor. Database documents are arranged *alphabetically by title* in a series of filing cabinets, behind the photocopiers.

The displayed shelf number for vertical files is not used to locate physical items. At a future date, the shelf number for all items in vertical files will show as "VERTICAL FILE".

The Archives area is normally available for use during the academic year from Monday through Friday from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm. (8:30 am to 4:00 pm, May through August). Public workstations are available in Archives, with access to the Library's [catalogue](#) and the Internet, to assist in locating items in the Database.

Documents located in the Archives and Rare Books Section cannot be removed from the first floor, and must be consulted on site. For each item consulted, users are requested to sign a register, indicating their name, their user barcode number, and the barcode of the item being consulted and its title. A photocopier is available in the Archives to copy documents from the vertical files.

When consulting items from the vertical files, users should work quietly, and respect other researchers' need to complete their work without being distracted or disturbed.

PERIODICALS (2D FLOOR)

Items with the location "**PERIODICALS (2D FLOOR)**" are found in the journal collection, located on the second floor. Journals are shelved by Library of Congress classification number, and must be used on site. Photocopy machines are available on the second and third floors to make copies of journal articles.

Each record for a journal citation includes, as part of the Library of Congress call number for the journal, the volume and issue number for the indexed article.

Journal articles were indexed in the Database primarily for the period 1989 through 1996, with some articles indexed retrospectively to the early or mid-1980s. With the increasing availability of online full text and indexing/abstracting services, the Database is no longer creating citations for journal articles. To find current journal articles on mining and its environmental impact, search in one of the online databases available through your Library. For Laurentian users, a listing of online services is available at [Library Databases](#). Off-campus access to Laurentian databases requires proxy authentication.

MICROFICHE (2D FLOOR) or GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS (3D FLOOR).

Microfiche are located on the second floor, near the Library Help desk and the Learning Commons area, while government publications are on the third floor. Materials on microfiche are not available for loan, and must be consulted on site. Periodicals and newspapers on microfiche are arranged *alphabetically by title*. With the exception of legislative and statistical materials, items in the government documents collection are available for loan. Photocopy machines are available on the second and third floors to make copies of government documents. In addition, all the microtext readers on the second floor can print displayed pages from journals and other documents.

The displayed shelf number for Database citations on microfiche is a default control number, and is not used to locate physical items. At a future date, this number will be changed to "MICROFICHE".

CIRCULATION (3D FLOOR)

Items with the location "**CIRCULATION (3D FLOOR)**" can be found in the Library's circulating collection on the third floor. Citations with the location "**CIRCULATION (3D FLOOR)**", chiefly conference papers or chapters in books, are available for loan, like other books on the third floor.

1 Books CIRCULATION (3D FLOOR)

Each citation for a conference paper or a chapter from a book contains the same Library of Congress call number assigned as the shelving number for the conference or book as a whole, including volume numbers. For example, if the printed volume for a conference proceeding with 200 papers has the call number "TD 899 M5 I5 1991", the record for each of the 200 papers will display the same call number.

REGIONAL (1ST FLOOR)

If the location for a printed conference proceeding or a book says "**Material has been checked/charged out**", the conference proceeding or book has already been loaned to another student or professor.

The loan status of individual papers in a printed conference proceeding or chapters in a book is **NOT** updated when the conference volume or book is loaned. To verify the availability of a conference paper or book chapter, it is necessary to search by author for the name of the conference, or by title for the book, to see if the printed volume of the proceeding or book is still on the shelf and can be borrowed.

INTERNET

Database citations with the location "**INTERNET**" are electronic full text PDF files of conference papers, dissertations and theses, or selected journal articles. For conference papers and other full text materials, this location will display if the electronic version of the paper is the only copy available.

1 ELECTRONIC RESOURCE INTERNET

The displayed call number for electronic conference papers is "ONLINE / EN LIGNE".

If **both** print and electronic copies of a conference paper are available, the only location displayed is for the **print** version, and with the same call number assigned to the printed conference proceeding, as noted above. If an electronic version of the paper is also available, a link to the URL will display in the brief default display, at the right of the citation, and information about the PDF file will appear in

notes in the Details display, under the Catalog Record tab, with a link to the full text in a “HTTP” note.

Note that access to some full text citations by non-Laurentian users is not permitted, due to licensing requirements imposed by the product vendor or publisher. External researchers may locate restricted full text citations through the online databases of their home institution's library, or through interlibrary loan.

All Database citations with a link to a PDF file include a note, displayed in upper case, describing the terms of access to full text.

For PDF files that are restricted, the note is displayed in the following form:

Access restriction: ACCESS TO FULL TEXT RESTRICTED TO MEMBERS OF LAURENTIAN UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY. PROXY AUTHENTICATION REQUIRED FOR OFF-CAMPUS ACCESS.

For full text displays available with no restriction, the following note appears in each citation:

Access restriction: UNRESTRICTED ACCESS TO FULL TEXT
